In the Mr Tickle room the children have enjoyed lots of craft activities, painting for a display. In the sand the children have used the animal figures to enhance their play and used containers to fill and empty in the water tray. Key Workers have spent lots of time with their key children, reading stories and playing 1:1 games. Story and song time have included using the finger puppets this week and the children have found it a very entertaining activity. In role play the children have donned their hard hats for building work; using the tools to 'fix' just about everything in the class room! The farm and ball run have been other favourites this week.



This week in the Mr Chatterbox room the children have enjoyed fantasy play with the Castle and small world figures. They have also explored the wooden city road, working together to fit the pieces together to make a long and winding road! Story time has included stories such as Dazzling Diggers and Tremendous Tractors, certainly a vehicle theme to story time this week.

In the craft room the children have enjoyed using their hands for printing and used other tools such as sponges to decorate flower cut outs! In the sand tray the children have used small world

animals and have used funnels, jugs and sieves in the water tray. Outside the Mr Chatterbox children have practised hand eye movements and fine motor skills with the bats and balls, often very successful, will we see a few at Wimbledon in years to come?



Kindergarten 1 is our new classroom this term and appears to be very successful so far! The children have settled in extremely well and are thoroughly enjoying exploring all aspects of the room. The children have participated in number work and have created a number line, counting 1 - 10 easily. As we are in winter now the children have used that theme to create a display as well as listen to winter stories and completing winter themed puzzles. Hygiene is very important and the children have been demonstrating this by ensuring hands are washed correctly before meals and after toileting and also using tissues appropriately. The new computer is very popular and the children are thoroughly enjoying the games and activities they can do. On the craft table the children have explored play dough with hands and tools and have created some very unusual structures?? A great first week, roll on the next one!



In Kindergarten 2 class the children have been getting back into their familiar routines and have enjoyed time with key persons, building strong relationships. The children are also completing a winter display, glitter and cotton wool everywhere! Number lines have been used for ordering numbers 1 -20 and also recognition of these numbers.
