This week in the Kindergarten 1 and 2 classes the children have enjoyed looking at 'Kipper' story books and sounding out the letters to form words. Some of the children have traced over simple 3 letter words whilst others have written their own words. Chinese New Year has been celebrated and the children enjoyed making paper lanterns and playing dominoes.



ICT has been introduced in the form of 'Walkie Talkie's' and the children had great fun communicating with each other from opposite ends of the classroom. In PE this week the children have been practising tackling and dribbling skills in football. Hygiene is very important and the children are discussing this and the need to wash hands regularly.

The Mr Chatterbox room children have had a lovely week. They have continued to read 'Gruffalo' and 'Gruffalo's Child', which is becoming a firm favourite. The children have been tiptoeing around the Nursery so as not to wake the 'Big Bad Mouse' and can be heard in the home corner cooking favourite foods such as scrambled snake and owl ice cream! Bubbles have been enjoyed, both blowing them through a straw, jumping to pop and catch them and blowing mountains in the paint trays. The children did get to practice in plain water first, just to ensure they all knew how to blow! The craft table has been very busy; the children did both cutting and drawing for the craft display and painted 'Dora and Boots' for another display. The children have been encouraged to develop turn taking skills this week by participating in circle music time and playing Hungry Frogs game, using words such as 'my turn, your turn and next' to help the children understand.



In the Mr Tickle room the children have enjoyed singing and acting out many number songs and rhymes such as 5 Little Monkeys and 1,2,3,4,5! They have also explored the dressing bears and have attempted to do zips, press studs and buttons! Musical instruments have been used; from shaking to banging to blowing, making loud and occasionally quiet sounds! Playing with the Stickle Bricks, the Beebot and shape sorters have also been fun! In the craft room this week the children have explored the feeling of ice as they moved it over paper, making marks as they went! They have also explored the feeling of paint with their fingers and the sounds it makes as it squelches between their fingers!
